A READING FROM THE BOOK OF CONCORD
THE SMALCALD ARTICLES
PART II, ARTICLE I: THE CHIEF ARTICLE

The first and chief article is this:

That Jesus Christ, our God and Lord, died for our sins and was raised again for our justification (Romans 4:24–25).

He alone is the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world (John 1:29), and God has laid on Him the iniquities of us all (Isaiah 53:6).

All have sinned and are justified freely, without their own works or merits, by His grace, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, in His blood (Romans 3:23–4).

This it is necessary to believe. This cannot be otherwise acquired or grasped by any work, law, or merit. Therefore, it is clear and certain that this faith alone justifies us. As St. Paul says, “For we hold that one is justified by faith apart from the works of the Law” (Romans 3:28). “That He might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith Jesus” (Romans 3:26).
